

PAPERWORK PREP CHECKLIST

Property Survey : Map of your property's boundaries (title company will request, not mandatory). Not applicable for condos/townhomes/villas.
Title Work : If your home was purchased within the last 3-5 years (title company may request, not mandatory).
Mortgage Documents: Details the mortgage and balance (title company will need). IF applicable share info on any lines of equity, liens, or if PACE program was used.
Warranties and Manuals: For appliances that will stay with the home (optional).
Property Floorplan (optional).
FAQ's About the Property: Most requested Buyer questions. See attached.
Fill out Property Disclosures . See attached.
Property Features Sheet: List all builder upgrades and owner upgrades. See attached
Utility Bills : Recent bills for electricity, cable/internet, water, gas, etc. These are helpful when filling out the FAQ's Sheet About the Property.
Insurance Records : Homeowners insurance details and claim history (helpful when filling out the FAQ's Sheet About the Property, Property Disclosures, and might aid Buyer in getting insurance if they are having challenges).
Association Documents : Articles of Incorporation, bylaws, amendments or supplements if any, current rules, fees, current budget, financials, and FAQ Sheet (all are mandatory if you are selling a condo/ townhome/ villa). And if applicable the Milestone Inspection Report; Structural Integrity Reserve Study; Turnover Inspection Reports (applies to structures that are 3 stories or more with the first floor being habitable). Homeowner can request from the management company or retrieve from community website. I will assist where I can with helping you retrieve these.
If you are part of a HOA or COA please collect management company's name, property manger's name, phone, and most important email address. Include Master Association information if applicable.
